



140 Acts of Prayer

Ordered by time of occurrence
with the specific rulings for
each praying person

This is a step-by-step prayer guide that consists of the different acts of prayer. In it you will find different acts and its rulings: the obligatory acts, the Sunnah ones, the recommended ones, the disliked ones and the acts that invalidate the prayer. You will also learn that rulings may differ depending on the type of person praying: some rulings are specific for the imam, some are specific for the *munfarid* (person praying alone) and some are specific for the person following the imam.
